

Design-A-Marble Colouring Competition Guidelines

- You may submit an entry for the Design-A-Marble Colouring Competition online or in person (at our site in Bovey Tracey).
- You can complete your online entry at <https://visit.houseofmarbles.com/design-a-marble-colouring-competition> or by scanning the QR code on the competition entry form.
- Competition entry forms can be collected in the Games Garden at our tourist site at House of Marbles, The Old Pottery, Pottery Road, Bovey Tracey TQ13 9DS between the competition dates (14th July – 5th September 2023). You must visit the site between the dates to enter as the entry form will not be available elsewhere.
- Multiple entries are allowed per person, although only one entry per person will be submitted to a public vote on our Facebook page, after the 5th September 2023, and having made it to the finals.
- The top four finalists will be put to the public vote through an emoji voting competition on the main House of Marbles Facebook page (<https://www.facebook.com/HouseOfMarblesPage>). The public voting will be displayed and commence from Friday, 8th September through to 9:00am, 22nd September. The winner will be the design with the most emoji votes, that match to the corresponding design and will be announced later that day on Facebook.
- The winner will be notified on our news channels and will also be contacted directly with their contact information provided.
- Entries that are submitted without all the relevant information provided (or written entries that are illegible) may be void and excluded from the competition.
- As a kindness to other participants, please return your crayons/colouring pens back in the case provided if participating on site.
- Management reserves the right to withdraw entries at their discretion.

Teign Valley Glass Studios will make every effort to re-create the winning design in glass as closely as possible (although there may be some slight variations due to the making process and interpretation of the design).

How To Submit a Suitable Digital Photo

If you are submitting an entry on our website, you will need to take a suitable digital photo of the completed design.

The quality of your digital photo must be:

- clear and in focus
- large enough to see the details
- in colour
- unaltered by computer software
- large enough/high enough quality to see the details clearly
- contain no other objects or people / nothing covering any part of the page

- be cropped to the page
- be taken with good even lighting / not have any shadows across the page

We regret that we cannot receive digital entries via email or over social media (or any other method). If you are unable to submit a digital version of the entry form, then please drop your competition form into the locked entry box provided on site.
